

Free Pattern No: 4
HANDKERCHIEF
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Abbreviations

Australian/English	American
chain=ch	ch
dc=double crochet	sc
tr=treble	dc
sl st=slip stitch	sl st
beg=beginning	

Materials: 1 Handkerchief that has been hemstitched.

20grams NO 30 crochet cotton (or cotton size of your choice) with 20 grams of NO 30 cotton you will be able to make 4.

1.00mm crochet hook.

1st round: Start in any centre hole of any corner. Insert hook into hole draw cotton through make 1ch, 3dc in same hole, 2dc in next hole, *1dc in next hole, rep from * having the number of dc divisible by 6, (*you might have to put 2dc in some holes to get the right amount*) to 1 hole before next corner, 2dc in next hole, 3dc in corner hole, rep from first* all around the handkerchief omitting the corner at end of last rep, join with a sl st in first dc made.

2nd round: sl st in next dc, (3ch, 1tr, 3ch, 2tr) in same dc as sl st, *1ch, miss 2dc, (1dc, 3ch, 1dc) in next dc, 1ch, miss 2dc, (2tr, 3ch, 2tr) in next dc, rep from * all around the handkerchief, omitting the (2tr, 3ch, 2tr) at end of last rep, join with a sl st in 3rd of 3ch made at beg.

3rd round: sl st into next tr, sl st in next 3ch loop, 6ch, sl st in 3rd ch from the hook, 1ch, (1tr in same loop as sl st, 3ch, sl st in top of last tr, 1ch,) twice in same loop as sl st, 1tr in same loop as sl st, 2ch, 1dc in next 3ch loop, 2ch * (1tr, 3ch, sl st in top of last tr, 1ch) 3 times in next 3ch loop, 1tr in same loop, 2ch, 1dc in next 3ch loop, 2ch, rep from * to end, join with a sl st in 3rd of 6ch made at beg, fasten off. Sew all ends in securely.

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
